




DE Opportunities

- Art History: DE Art History I (Art credit) **NO MORE AP ART HISTORY**

Band Students...



- All Band Students should schedule Advanced Band
- If you want more than one hour of band you should also choose Instrumental Technique
- Only schedule Percussion and Jazz if you have permission from Mrs. Morgan and Mr. Suarez



Team Sports

- If you are on a sports team roster you must schedule TEAM SPORTS
- If you are a senior football player, you must schedule TEAM SPORTS S1 and add a ½ credit elective to offset
- If you are a multisport athlete that then you must schedule TEAM SPORTS S1 and TEAM SPORTS S2
 - Example would be football in fall and baseball in spring.

- No SCHEDULE = MRS. OWENS CHOICE



Welcome to the Denham Springs High School Class Registration System for 2024-2025

Students will select courses for the 2024-2025 school year from the courses listed below. All students must attend school for (8) class periods unless they are enrolled in CTE Internship. Students and parents should consider graduation requirements, college entrance requirements and TOPS requirements when selecting courses the student will take each year of high school. To enter online course requests, click on the vellow pencil and the courses offered for that subject area will appear. More than one course can be selected in that subject area if needed. Remember to click "SUBMIT" once you have completed entering all requested courses. If the schedule was entered correctly, a copy of your current course registration screen will appear. An error message will appear if there is a problem with your current course requests. Students will complete this online registration of courses and will be allowed to make schedule corrections until the course registration period closes on Monday, March 18th @ 7:00 AM. At that time, online course registration will be closed and schedule changes will no longer be permitted. Once the student has completed online registration, please print a paper copy of their final course requests. The printed copy must be signed/dated by both the student and the parent or legal quardian. This signed copy will also serve as written confirmation of receipt of both the current diploma and TOPS requirements.






